DAY 01 SINGAPORE - TEL AVIV

(Meals On Board)

Assemble at Singapore Changi International Airport for your flight to Tel Aviv – The Capital of Israel.

DAY 02 TEL AVIV - OLD JAFFA - CAESAREA - HAIFA

(Dinner)

Welcome to Israel! On arrival, proceed to the ancient **Old City of Jaffa** and we visit its ancient quarters, the Artist's Quarter and the Old Port, it being the oldest sea – port in the whole world. Our tour will also include the Jaffa Clock Square, the archeological sites, the renovated Old City and the special atmosphere of the Artist's Colony. View of the once upon a time active port, Hasan El Bek Mosque. After lunch, we continue our visit with a drive along the Coastal Road to **Caesarea**, an ancient Mediterranean city half way between Tel Aviv and Haifa, containing many ruins most of which date from the Crusader period. Thereafter, continue to Haifa.

DAY 03 HAIFA - NAZARETH - CAPEMAUM - TABGHA

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Haifa, splendid Mediterranean port city, situated in a great golf at the Foot of Mount Carmel. We will visit the Shrine of Stella Maris on **Mount Carmel**, take a look at the **Bahia Temple** cult. Thereafter, continue to **Nazareth** for a visit of the Church of the Annunciation and St. Joseph Church. Visit the ancient **Capernaum**, where Jesus performed many miracles – Jesus's town and the center of his activities in the Galilee.

Continue to **Tabgha**, the church of the Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes. Visit of the **Boat Museum**, named after the discovery, excavation and conservation of the Ancient Boat, known as the celebrated Jesus Boat, followed by a **Boat ride on the Sea of Galilee**.

DAY 04 JORDAN RIVER - DEAD SEA - MASADA - JERUSALEM

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Drive along side the Jordan River to The Dead Sea area. We arrive to the factory of **AHAVA** Cosmetics Center, products of which are made from the natural minerals of the Sea, and stock their products in this Center but at far more attractive prices than elsewhere. **MASADA** - Go up with the Cable Car to the fortress of Masada, one of the most exciting and frequently visited sites in Israel, relating to a story of perseverance and power, faith and surrender, ambitions and a tragic end. Descend by cable car. Drive to Jericho it being the still inhabited oldest city in the world and visit **Qasr Al Yehud**, the spot where John the Baptist baptized Jesus. Now we have the lucky opportunity to enjoy **pampering and relaxation** at the biggest natural Spa in the world. We shall float on the mineral rich waters of the dead sea and have a Dead Sea Mud Wrap to get the real feeling of the Mineral rich mud of the Dead Sea.

DAY 05 JERUSALEM - MT OF OLIVES - BETHLEHEM - JERUSALEM

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

We ascend the **Mount of Olives** where we have an unforgettable breathtaking panoramic view of the old and the modern city of Jerusalem. Descend to Gethsemane and visit the **Church of all Nations** and the **Church of Mary's Tomb**. Drive to **Bethlehem**, where we shall visit the **Church of Nativity** built on top of the grotto where Jesus is believed to have been born. Return to Jerusalem.

DAY 06 JERUSALEM

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

We enter the Old City through one of its gates. Visit the Western Wall. Continue with a visit to the **WESTERN WALL TUNNEL**, an underground tunnel exposing the full length of the Western Wall. View of the Dome of the Rock and the El Aqsa Mosque, both situated on the Temple Mount. Walking through the **Jewish Quarter** now restored and modernized with the Main Street from the time of the Romans: The Cardo. Continue through the **Christian Quarter** to visit the "Via Dolorosa", up to the Holy Sepulcher Church. Stroll through the **Moslem Quarter** with its colorful Bazaars.



DAY 07 JERUSALEM - AMMAN

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, spend some time at leisure before you cross the border to Amman, the capital of Jordan. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel.

DAY 08 AMMAN - MADABA - WADI MUJIB - KERAK - PETRA

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Drive south through the **king's way**, an ancient route that still has marks left from traders, armies and pilgrims who crossed it centuries ago. Visit **Mount Nebo**, the site of the endearing **monastery** and onto the Christian Town of **Madaba "The City of Mosaics"**. Proceed to **Kerak** through **Wadi Mujib**, a deep

valley featuring one of Jordan's most breathtaking views. Thereafter, visit the Kerak castle with its diverse history dated from the Byzantine to the Mamluk period. Lastly, proceed on to Petra for overnight.

DAY 09 PETRA - BEIDA - WADI RUM

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Petra is justifiably on most people's list of 'must-visit' places. It is the jewel of Jordan, the lost city of the biblical Nabateans, an impressive series of tombs and dwellings hidden behind ornate facades. Dating back to the 6th century BC. The iconic Petra view – the Treasury's glorious facade, glimpsed from the narrow cleft known as the Siq – is arguably the single most striking sight of the entire region. Petra's greatest surprise, however, is its size. After the visit, proceed to **Beida**, also known as **Little Petra**, the place where Nabateans used to entertain their guests. Continue south to the enchanting desert of Wadi Rum for a **4x4 jeep tour** inside the Wadi. You will visit several of Wadi Rum's distinctive **rock formations** and soak in the vast silence and spectacular desert landscapes.



DAY 10 WADI RUM - AMMAN

(Breakfast/Dinner)

After breakfast, transfer back to Amman. Upon arrival, free at own leisure. You may want to walk the streets, where you'll soon hear "Welcome to Jordan" from the locals. Maybe pick up a coffee from one of the cafés and partner it with an ara'yes, a toastie filled with spicy mincemeat.

DAY 11 AMMAN - SINGAPORE

(Breakfast)

Breakfast. Transfer to the airport.
