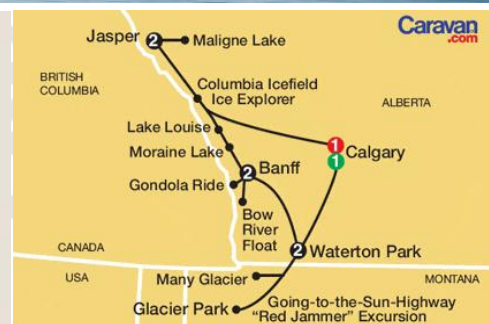

DAY 4 JUNEAU, ALASKA (B/L/D)

Arrive **Juneau** at 11am, the first docking port till 10pm. Juneau, the capital city of Alaska State. Enjoy what is truly an outdoorsman's paradise, with activities you won't find anywhere else. Go for a ride on a dog sled, whale watching, hiking, nature watching, flight seeing, ziplining and more on your own expenses. Or enjoy a slow walk to downtown for photo taking and souvenir shops.

DAY 5 SKAGWAY, ALASKA (B/L/D)

Arrive **Skagway** at 6 am in the morning till 8 pm depart. Skagway was the gateway to the gold fields for the thousands who flocked to Alaska and the Yukon with the hope of striking it rich. The gold rush was a boon and by 1898, Skagway was Alaska's largest town with a population of about 20,000. White Pass & Yukon Route Railroad, The "Scenic Railway of the World" links Skagway with Yukon, Canada. A 41-mile roundtrip offers an unforgettable journey to the summit of the White Pass, a 2,865-foot elevation.

DAY 6 CRUISING GLACIER BAY NATIONAL PARK, ALASKA (B/L/D)

Arrive **Glacier Bay National Park** at 6 am till 3 pm depart. Princess is one of a select few cruise lines permitted to cruise the pristine waters of Glacier Bay, the highlight of our 7-day Voyage of the Glaciers cruise. Just west of Juneau, this breathtaking national park and preserve boasts some of the world's most spectacular tidewater glaciers, such as Margerie Glacier, which often drops colossal chunks of ice into the sea. DAY 7 KETCHIKAN, ALASKA (B/L/D)

Located on an island, Ketchikan began life as an Indian fishing camp. The name Ketchikan comes from a Tlingit phrase that means "eagle with spread-out wings," a reference to a waterfall near town. Visitors to Ketchikan will be intrigued by its rich Native heritage, which includes the world's oldest collection of totem poles at Totem Heritage Center.

DAY 9 SEATTLE -VANCOUVER (B)
