### DAY 01 SINGAPORE - RIO DE JANEIRO

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your pleasant flight to Brazil.

### DAY 02 RIO DE JANEIRO

(Dinner)

Welcome to the bustling city of Rio de Janeiro, one of Brazil's most popular and frequented tourist destinations for decades. Its vibrant city centre is bursting with culture and pulsating with a deep sense of history and heritage. Upon arrival, check in and enjoy a much needed rest.

### DAY 03 RIO DE JANEIRO

(Breakfast/Lunch/Brazil Churrascaria Dinner)

After breakfast, you will ride along the famous Rio beaches to the **Sugarloaf** cable car. Ride first to the 'Morro da Urca' mountain at 886 feet (270 meters) above sea level and then continue to the top of **Sugarloaf Mountain**, 1,295 feet (395 meters) above sea level. Thereafter, you will continue ascend the 2,460 feet high mountain peak of **Corcovado** (Hunchback), famous for the statue of **Christ the Redeemer**, one of the New 7 Wonders of the top of the Corcovado Mountain.



### DAY 04 RIO DE JANEIRO - IGUAZU FALLS

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, transfer to airport for your flight to Iguazu. Upon arrival, enjoy a scenic drive as you reach world's widest waterfall – The Iguazu Waterfalls. At a vantage point, you will have a panoramic view of some of the 275 waterfalls. If time permits, you may consider taking up a adventurous and breadth-taking riverboat ride across the falls.

### DAY 05 IGUAZU FALLS (ARGENTINA) - BUENOS AIRES

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Today, you will embark on an exciting journey to Iguazu falls, Argentina, including an ecological train ride to the **Devil's Throat**. You will pass the Iguazu River. Trails through the 137,000 acre reserve provide a different, complete view of the falls. After that, transfer for your flight to Buenos Aires. Arrival at Buenos Aires and transfer to the hotel.

### DAY 06 BUENOS AIRES

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

We shall begin the day with a visit to the impressive National Congress, the Civic Centre, **Plaza de Mayo** (May Square) surrounded by the Government House (Casa Rosada). Along 9<sup>th</sup> July Avenue, you will see the famous **Colon theatre**, considered one of the best opera houses in the world. You will then head to the traditional **San Telmo** neighbourhood in which you will be taken back in history. A bit further south is one of the oldest neighbourhoods, **La Boca**, the settlement for the first Italian immigrants, where you will have time to enjoy the colorful and unique architecture. Lastly, view the **Puerto Madero** and **Retiro** on the way to **Palemo**, the largest residential area of the city.

### DAY 07 BUENOS AIRES - LIMA - CUSCO (PERU)

(Breakfast/Dinner)

After breakfast, hop on a flight that takes you to Lima, and continue domestic flight to Cusco. Upon arrival, Visit the magnificent temple "Koricancha" site where in the Empire period hosted sacred relics from the territory. It was a place of very high importance for the Inca ritual while political and religious building includes the famous temple dedicated to the Sun whose rounded walls of polished stone are considered the best works of the Incan art.

### DAY 08 CUSCO - SACRED VALLEY

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Departure to Sacred Valley via Pisac. Visit the village of **Pisac** to participate in the market. Starting with the main square where a **Pisonay centennial** hanging moss lies. Next, continue to the **Maras Salt mines**. These salt mines cling to the hillside and divided into many saltwater pools, among the oldest of Peru. Lastly, move on to **Ollantaytambo**, visit the "village" of which the layout of streets, squares, and foundations of houses is Inca.



#### DAY 09 SACRED VALLEY - MACHU PICCHU - CUZCO

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

This morning, we'll be transferred to the train station for your Vista dome train journey to Machu Picchu – "Old Mountain" located at a 15<sup>th</sup> Century Inca Site 2,430 Metres above sea-level. A memorable visit at this UNESCO World Heritage Site includes archaeological treasures like the Inca Bridge, the Intihuatana "Astronomic Clock/Calendar", the Temple of the Sun, and the Room of the Three Windows. Lots of ruins, bridges, temples, sanctuaries, parks and residences can also be found around this site otherwise known as "the Lost City of the Incas". For lunch, a local Machu Picchu buffet lunch awaits your arrival. Next, we will embark on journey back to Cusco via train where we will retire for the day back at the hotel after dinner.

#### DAY 10 CUZCO - PUNO

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, transfer to Puno (3,860 Meters Above Sea-Level) - the "Folkloric Capital of Peru" due to its wealth of artistic and cultural expressions particularly in its vast variety of extravagant regional dances. You will get to enjoy an incredible view of the herds of alpaca, llamas grazing on these highland pampas, interspersed with lots of tiny villages, not forgetting about the majestic backdrop of the Andes Mountains. Streets, alleys, parks, gardens, markets and plazas filled with endless interesting and exotic Andean flavours.

#### DAY 11 PUNO - LAKE TITICACA - PUNO

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Today, you shall proceed towards Lake Titicaca - the highest commercially navigable lake in the world at 3,811 Meters Above Sea-Level! You shall visit the hilly island of **Taquile**. Upon a strenuous climb of about 600 stone steps to the hub of the island, you will be well-rewarded by the magnificent views of Lake Titicaca, together with the surrounding mountains. The people of Taquile - "Taquilenos" are known for their colourful and fine hand-woven textiles and clothings as well as their warm hospitality.



#### DAY 12 PUNO - LIMA

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Depart Puno to Lima. Upon arrival, embark on Lima sightseeing tour which will include Saint Martin Square, Parliament House, Spanish Bull Fight Arena and Lima most beautiful colonial mansion, **Palacio de Torre Tagel**.

#### DAY 13 LIMA - NAZCA LINE ADVENTURE - PARACAS

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

This morning, head towards Paracas for sightseeing tour to view the extraordinary **Nazca Lines**. These geoglyphs, which were drawn between 500 B.C. And 500 A.D. For approximately 450km along Nazca Lines, we will also admire the view of the desserts and the

Pacific ocean. Enjoy a adventurous ride on the **scenic flight** to experience **birdseye view** of these geoglyphs. After that, head back to Paracas for our overnight stay.



#### DAY 14 PARACAS - LIMA

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Today, make a visit to the wonderful **bay of Paracas**, this bay is formed on the north part of the peninsula of Paracas, and has special historical significance of Peruvian. We shall embark on an exciting journey to **Bird Island**. Wharf by cruise where you will be able to have a beautiful glance at the graceful sea lions, penguins and birds which amounted to a thousand along the way. On the beaches of this bay, it is frequent to find Andean parihuana (flamingos) of beautiful red and white plumage, which inspired Jose de San Martin for the Peruvian Flag. After lunch, head back to Lima.

#### DAY 15 LIMA - SANTIAGO

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, board our flight to Santiago. Upon arrival, visit the historic center of Santiago, surrounded by very modern districts. In the colonial district, visiting the **Casa de La Moneda**, the seat of government and on to the **Plaza de Armas** to discover colonial architecture and republican monuments such as **the Cathedral** (nineteenth century). Then departure to the **Lastarria neighborhood** to discover the **Church of Veracruz** and the mansion **Plaza Mulato Gil of Castro**.

#### DAY 16 SANTIAGO

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Departure to Valparaíso to visit the city and its historic harbor dating back to 1536 and classified as UNESCO World heritage. Walk through the streets lined with colorful houses meandering hills and mountains with panoramic views of the Pacific.

#### DAY 17 SANTIAGO - SAO PAULO

(Breakfast/Dinner)

This morning, free at own leisure. In the afternoon, we shall depart by domestic flight to Sao Paulo.

#### DAY 18 SAO PAULO - SINGAPORE

(Breakfast)

After breakfast, we'll be warmly received by the local city guide for a sweet visit of this richly-cultured metropolitan city. Our sightseeing tour of Sao Paulo begins with a trip to the Metropolitan Cathedral, Liberdade the Grand Ipiranga Palace, Paulista Street. After that, we shall transfer to the airport for our flight back to Singapore.
