## DAY 01 SINGAPORE → CHRISTCHURCH

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to Christchurch. **Ōtautahi Christchurch**, a revitalised city in the heart of Aotearoa New Zealand's South Island. It is one of the world's most unique destinations, combining urban regeneration and innovation with heritage, culture and exhilarating activity.

## DAY 02 CHRISTCHURCH - LAKE TEKAPO

(Meals on Board / Dinner)

Kia Ora , Welcome to New Zealand. Upon arrival, you will be met and greet by South Island representative at the airport. Visit to **Christchurch Antarctic Centre**. Brave an Antarctic storm, go off-road in a **Hägglund Antarctic vehicle ride**, befriend a **husky sled dog** and mingle with the **little blue penguins**. Experience Antarctica from all four dimensions and leave with a head full of knowledge & inspiration. Next head to **Riverside Market** for a unique inner-city shopping experience. Discover the fascinating history of Christchurch on a sightseeing tour covering the central city highlights, including **Cathedral Square**, **Victoria Square**, **Thomas Edmonds former band rotunda** and the **Avon River**, **Town Hall**, the **floral clock**, **Law Courts**, **Provincial Chambers**, **Christ's College**, **Museum**, **Botanical Gardens**, **Arts Centre**, **Worcester Boulevard**, and the **Bridge of Remembrance**. On leaving the inner city, the tour includes several parks and gardens including **Mona Vale Gardens** and **Hagley Park**. Then learn the history & explore the cultural and natural heritage of the Region at at **Canterbury Museum**. Then to **Riccarton House**, **Riccarton Bush**, and the **University of Canterbury**.

Travel to the **Sign of the Takahe** providing spectacular views over the city. Inland route via **the scenic Rakaia Gorge** through South Canterbury to **Ashburton**, visit **Farmer's Corner Wholesale Shopping & Alpaca Farm**, a typical attraction wherein a close encounter with nut feeding & photos with the Alpacas is definitely an unforgettable moment. Continue into the Mackenzie country to see the turquoise colour of **Lake Tekapo**, visit the famous **Church of the Good Shepherd** and **The Bronze Sheepdog Statue**.

### DAY 03 LAKE TEKAPO - MT COOK REGION - QUEENSTOWN

(Breakfast / Dinner)

The drive from **Lake Tekapo** to **Queenstown** is one of the most beautiful road trips in New Zealand. A quick stop at **Pukaki Lookout Point** for a **panoramic view of Mt Cook**. Stop at **High Country Alpine Salmon Farm** for **salmon tasting**. Next to **Cromwell**, **Mrs Jones Fruits Stall**, one of the best-known fruit stalls in Central Otago, stocks a huge array of fresh fruits, dried fruits, nuts, honey products etc. Visit **AJ Hackett Bungy – Kawarau Bridge Bungy**. No visit to New Zealand would be complete without a stop at the Kawarau Bungy. Home of the world's first and most famous 43 metre Bungy Jump. Dare to take the challenge at own expenses. Enjoy the stunning views as you ride the **Skyline Gondola cable car** high above **Queenstown** and **Lake Wakatipu** to the **top of Bob's Peak**. The best views in the region spread out in a spectacular 220-degree panorama with breath taking views of **Coronet Peak**, **The Remarkables mountain range** and across **Lake Wakatipu** to Cecil and **Walter Peak**. Tonight's dinner at **Fergburger** a Queenstown famous restaurant which specialises in gourmet hamburgers.

### DAY 04 QUEENSTOWN

(Breakfast)

After breakfast, **Spend the day at leisure**. Highly recommend to join a full day tour to Milford Sound. Spectacular waterfalls and water-sculpted rocks. Venture into Milford Sound, a New Zealand treasure carved by ice age glaciers and famously described as the eighth wonder of the world. Fiordland is one of the world's last great wildernesses.

### DAY 05 QUEENSTOWN - WANAKA - GLACIER REGION (B / D)

Begin our day to **Arrowtown** - a village was once the hurley burley **centre of the gold rush**. The town has been preserved with its main street still retaining the flavour of the 1860's. Enjoy a pleasant scenic drive the **Shotover** and **Clutha Rivers** to **Wanaka**. The lakeside town of Wanaka can provide you with an appealing mix of fine living. It has a plenty of cafes and interesting shops. Travel past **Lake Hawea** via **Makaroa** to the **Haast Pass**. Although lower than the other alpine passes, Haast is the mightiest, surrounded by high peaks and forests, with many waterfalls visible from the highway. Continue north to the **West Coast Glacier Region**.

### DAY 06 GLACIER REGION - PUNAKAIKI - GREYMOUTH (B / D)

After breakfast, this morning is free time to explore **Glacier Region**. We highly recommend you to join scenic Helicopter ride or West Coast Wildlife Centre Admission at own expenses. Next travelling along the **West Coast Road**. Explore the goldfield walkway at Ross, stop by the shores of Lake Ianthe. The town of **Hokitika** is famous for **New Zealand Pounamu** (Jade) and gold. Continue travel to **Punakaiki** and visit its amazing **limestone formations**, known as the **Pancake Rocks**, where the ocean shoots up into the air as part of the **natural blowholes** at high tide.



### DAY 07 GREYMOUTH - CHRISTCHURCH (Breakfast / Dinner)

Classic west coast river and forest scenery leads you east as you travel from **Greymouth** to **Arthur's Pass**. Rushing water, impressive bridges and tiny towns gradually give way to the misty mountains of the Southern Alps. The route known as **Arthur's Pass** was first used by Māori tribes crossing to the west coast to find pounamu (Jade). Today it's a sophisticated mountain pass, memorable for its scenery as well as its breathtaking civil engineering. The road follows the **Waimakariri** and **Bealey Rivers** down to the skiing areas of Porter Heights and Craigieburn. Lakes Pearson and Grasmere are photo opportunities along the way. Rural serenity and friendly towns lead you across the Canterbury Plains to Christchurch. You'll pass **Kirwee**, **Darfield**, **Sheffield** and **Springfield**.



### DAY 8 CHRISTCHURCH → SINGAPORE

(Breakfast)

This morning, after breakfast, if time permits, you can do some last-minute shopping before your transfer to the airport for your flight home.

## 第一天 新加坡→基督城

乘搭班机飞往**新西兰南岛**最大最繁荣的城市-**基督城**。新西兰是最靠近南极的国家，被誉为“世界上最后一片净土”。气候凉爽景色宜人。一起畅游新西兰来体验原始旷野和多彩文化！

## 第二天 基督城-蒂卡波湖

(机上用餐/晚餐)

抵达基督城，参观**国际南极中心**亲身体验到南极的四季变化，接受南极风暴的挑战，与哈士奇与小蓝企鹅家族亲密接触，室内景点游无限4D表演和体验**哈格南极越野车**。之后继续城市观光基督城，上帝的后花园，街上是十九世纪英式古典气息的建筑。参观**河滨市场**体验当地风情，开启观光包括古老的**坎特伯里博物馆**，**植物园**、优美的**雅芳河**等。经阿什伯顿来到**Farmers Corner** 市级和**羊驼牧场**参观。与可爱的羊驼拍照后前往**蒂卡波湖**。小镇的北面是碧绿的湖水，湖对岸就是雄伟的南阿尔卑斯山。参观这座唯美复古的建筑**好牧羊人教堂**，与**牧羊犬雕像**合影。您也可以漫步于蒂卡波步道。在冬天，你可能有机会看到特卡波湖地区著名的南极光。夏天，你会看到鲁冰花盛开。来到举世闻名的‘观星小镇’你也可以选择自费参加约翰山天文台的观星体验，加深对宇宙的认知，点燃探索星空的激情。

## 第三天 蒂卡波湖-库克山-皇后镇

(早餐/晚餐)

早餐后，您将在美丽的**普卡基湖**前拍照留念，欣赏**库克山国家公园**的景色。**奥拉基山**是最纯粹意义上的阿尔卑斯山-与高耸入云的山峰，冰川和永久的雪原，所有美景都在星罗棋布的天下。接着参观**鲑鱼养殖场**体验**喂鲑鱼**和**品尝新鲜鲑鱼生鱼片**。之后来到**瓊斯太太的果园(克伦威尔镇)**你一定不想错过的水果小镇。出发前往**皇后镇**路上我们经过**卡瓦劳大桥蹦极**，观看游客从43米的高空一坠而下，体验无比刺激，惊心动魄的感觉。您也可以自费参加！乘坐**空中缆车**到达皇后镇的顶部，同时欣赏城市全景及瓦卡蒂普湖，形如闪电，是新西兰第三大湖泊。晚餐会是皇后镇赫赫有名的**Fergburger 大汉堡**。

## 第四天 皇后镇

(早餐)

早餐后，**自由活动**。你可以选择自费参加探索世界上最伟大的自然奇观之一**米佛峡湾**，来自大自然力量的壮观景色，几千年前在冰河时代塑造了这片土地。俗语说不游米佛峡湾不知海湾之眩、山林之魄、天地之风光。

## 第五天 皇后镇-瓦纳卡-冰川城

(早餐/晚餐)

早餐后出发前往**箭镇-淘金小镇**寻找魔戒取景地，风景美不胜收，一路开车来到新西兰第二大风景区-**瓦纳卡**。欣赏湖边小镇的自然美景与新西兰著名的**网红树-‘孤独树’**合影。经过**哈威亚湖**等景点之后前往**冰川城**，**福克斯冰川 & 弗朗兹约瑟夫冰川**在那里可以看到不可思议的冰山景色。



## 第六天 冰川城-普纳凯基-格雷茅斯

(早餐/晚餐)

早餐后，您可以自费参加新西兰福克斯冰川步行健行之旅，乘搭直升机观光和在冰川徒步绝对是您终身难忘的体验之一。**福克斯冰川 & 弗朗兹约瑟夫冰川**是世界上访问最多的冰山，那里还提供很多冒险项目例如冰山徒步，越野摩托车，直升机或者跳伞等。沿着西海岸前进，我们探索历史名镇**霍基蒂卡**是传统的**绿玉产地**。是了解西海岸迷人历史的好地方。倾听沉船、采金人和找绿玉的故事。参观**帕帕罗瓦国家公园普纳凯基的千层薄饼岩**和**Punakaiki 吹孔**，千层薄饼岩是經千萬年時間慢慢形成的地理奇蹟。



## 第七天 格雷茅斯-基督城

(早餐/晚餐)

早餐后，由**格雷茅斯**出发穿越**亞瑟峽谷國家公園**宽阔的视野，崎岖的山峰和广阔的原生山毛榉森林让您享受舒适的乘坐体验。沿着**73号公路**风景优美，路两边都是大牧场，遍地的大草原。经过**巨石阵**和**皮尔森湖**等景点拍照，如果您想要有不同的体验也可以自费乘坐举世闻名的**TranzAlpine**火车穿越**南阿尔卑斯山**，到达**基督城**。

## 第八天 基督城→新加坡

(早餐)

这个早晨，用完早餐后，如果时间允许，你可以利用空余时间去购物血拼，之后会送您去机场返回新加坡温暖的家。
