DAY 01 SINGAPORE - HAVANA

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to Latin Americas where your dream holiday begins!

DAY 02 TRANSIT CITY

Due to the journey and transit timing, we will take a break and rest in our transit city. Free at own leisure thereafter.

DAY 03 TRANSIT CITY - HAVANA

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Today, we will head to the airport and fly into the vibrant capital of Cuba, Havana. It is the largest city in the Caribbean, and one of the most culturally rich urban centers in the world.



DAY 04 HAVANA

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Explore the Old colonial town by foot. Your guide will show you the most important squares and sightseeing points: Palacio de los Capitanes Generales, Plaza de Armas, Castillo de la Real Fuerza, El Templete, Catedral, "Hemingways Bodeguita", Plaza San Francisco and Plaza Vieja. Visit the Museo del Ron "Fundation Havana Club" where you will learn everything about the production of Cuba's national drink. After lunch panoramic sightseeing by bus: Parque Central, Gran Teatro de Habana, Capitolio Nacional, Revolution Square, University, Cementery Colon, the residencial area Vedado where vou will notice the variety of arquitecture from Art Nouveau to Art Deco.

DAY 05 HAVANA - VINALES - HAVANA

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Start on the "Ruta del Tabaco" to the province of Pinar del Rio in the western part of Cuba. Panoramic sightseeing tour through the Mogote-Valley with its famous limestone rocks and the picturesque village of Viñales, where time

seems to stand still. Visit a "Casa del Veguero" (house of a tobacco farmer). In the afternoon visit the "Prehistoric Wall" a huge art work on a rock made by the Cuban Painter Gonzalez Morillo. Explore the Indian Cave on a boat trip. Thereafter, return back to Havana.



DAY 06 HAVANA - CANCUN

(Breakfast)

Board a flight to Cancun, the main gateway to the Mayan World and the Caribbean. Known for its impeccable beaches and striking blue seas, Cancun is also close to many legendary archaeological sites. Free at own leisure to enjoy Cancun.

DAY 07 CANCUN - CHICHEN ITZA - MERIDA

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Departure for Chichén Itza, the largest pre-Hispanic complex in Yucatan. This ceremonial center was built in the classical period by the Maya, but was invaded in the post-classical period by Toltec warriors, who came from the central plateau. The famous Kukulcan pyramid has inside an enlarged stone throne with a jaguar shape and jade eyes. Later, transfer to Merida.

DAY 08 MERIDA - MEXICO CITY

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Transfer to the Airport for our flight to Mexico City. Mexico City is considered one of the largest cities in the world, on a par with Seoul and Tokyo. The city was originally built on an island in the Texcoco Lake by the Aztecs in 1325 under the name of Tenochtitlan, which was nearly destroyed in the 1521 Siege of Tenochtitlan, and later redesigned and rebuilt according to Spanish planning standards.

DAY 09 MEXICO CITY

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

This morning, visit the National Museum of Anthropology (closed on Mondays). Considered one of the most beautiful museums in the world, a large modern building dating back to 1963 with a central courtyard half covered by a sculpted umbrella-shaped dome, it is the work of the Mexican architect Pedro Ramirez Vasquez. Next, visit the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City, with more than 20 million pilgrims every year, it is the most visited Catholic monument after the Vatican City. Lastly, visit the city's Zocalo. The Zócalo is the main square in the heart of the historic center of Mexico City and is one of the largest city squares in the world.



DAY 10 MEXICO CITY - TEOTIHUACAN - MEXICO CITY

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Visit the archaeological site of Teotihuacan, which was the most populated and dynamic city in the central valley. The temple of Quetzalcoatl, as well as the two imposing pyramids of the Sun and the Moon, are immutable witnesses of its glorious past. At the top of the pyramids you can have a super view that encompasses the entire plain.

DAY 11 MEXICO CITY - SAN JOSE (COSTA RICA)

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Today continue on to San Jose, Costa Rica. San José is the capital and the biggest city in Costa Rica. Enjoy the atmosphere of Avenida Central. Check out the historic post office building. Take a photo in the Catedral Metropolitana. Visit the National and Melico Salazar Theaters.

DAY 12 SAN JOSE - POAS VOLCANO - SAN JOSE

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Departure to the Poás Volcano National Park with your guide. This park has the biggest crater in the country, considered one of the biggest in the world, with 2 km in diameter and continuous fumaroles. The visit continues with a walk to the Botos lagoon, a magnificent lagoon with a greenish blue color, which fills an inactive crater, the extinct former crater. Active volcano with constant fumaroles, geyser crater, one of the biggest in the world, National Park trails, Botos lagoon, accessible for everybody. Then, visit the wonderful waterfalls of "La Paz" they have spectacular views.



DAY 13 SAN JOSE - PANAMA CITY

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Depart San Jose and fly to Panama. Panama City, the capital of Panama, is a modern city framed by the Pacific Ocean and man-made Panama Canal.

DAY 14 PANAMA CITY

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Start the day with a panoramic visit of the Amador Causeway, with a photo stop at the Biomuseum, designed by the famous architect Franck Gehry. Discover the colonial district called Casco Viejo (classified World Heritage Site by Unesco). Walk through the streets of this charming neighborhood: churches, Plaza de Francia (view on the modern city), Bolivar Square and many others.

DAY 15 PANAMA CITY - QUITO (ECUARDO)

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Today, prepare to fly into Quito, Ecuardo. Departure to the Middle of the World, which was established with precision crossing the Equator line in 1735 by French Geodesic Expedition. Visit the

small ethnological museum that tells the Ecuadorian ancestral culture.



DAY 16 QUITO

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Visit the historic center of Quito, World Heritage site by UNESCO. Discover its architectural heritage dating from the seventeenth and nineteenth centuries. Walk on the Independence Square where the Cathedral and the Archdiosese, embellished with arches and fountains. Walk on the esplanade which is always lively, located opposite the Church of San Francisco, built on the foundations of an Inca palace whose interior is home to masterpieces of Latin American religious art and surrounded by pretty colonial houses.

DAY 17 QUITO - BOGOTA

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Depart Quito and arrive into Bogota. Firstly, visit the Gold Museum, owned by the Bank of Colombia. Archaeologists have also contributed greatly in this collection creating a total of about 36000 pieces of gold and splendid emeralds. Thereafter free at own leisure.

DAY 18 BOGOTA

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Start with a visit to The Monserrate, from where you can have a wonderful view of the city, a magnificent panoramic point of the town. This place can be reached by cable car or funicular. Continue to a walking tour in the historic center, La Candelaria and discovery all houses and churches of the XVIII and XIX centuries. On the way to the "Plaza Bolívar", you will see "Casa de Nariño", home of the President of Colombia. Around the "Plaza Bolívar"

is located the "Capitolio Nacional", the "Palacio de Justicia", the "Alcaldía Mayor" of Bogotá, but also the "Catedral Primada", the "Capilla del Sagrario" and the "Palacio del Arzobispado".

DAY 19 BOGOTA - TRANSIT CITY

(Breakfast)

Free at own leisure till time for us to transfer to the Airport for our flight back to Transit city.

DAY 20 TRANSIT CITY

Overnight stay in the City.

DAY 21 TRANSIT CITY - SIN

(Breakfast)

Free at leisure until our transfer to the airport for our flight back to Singapore.

DAY 22 SINGAPORE

Arrive home in Singapore with a sweet and memorable holiday with us at Super Travels!
