DAY1: Singapore → Nagoya (MOB)
Tonight, assemble at Singapore Changi
Airport for your flight to Japan for a
pleasant & memorable journey.

Day 2: Nagoya-Takayama-Shirakawa-Nagano (L/D)

【 Takayama Old Town 】 Takayama's old town has been beautifully preserved with many buildings and whole streets of houses dating from the Edo Period (1600-1868), when the city thrived as a wealthy town of merchants.

【 Takayama Jinya 】 The Takayama Jinya served as the local government office headed by the officials dispatched from Edo.

Shirakawa Declared a UNESCO world heritage site in 1995, they are famous for their traditional gasshozukuri farmhouses, some of which are more than 250 years old.

Day 3: Nagano - Tokyo (B/L/D)

【Asakusa Kannon Sensoji】 to see
the city's oldest temple in its iconic
vibrant colors. Along the way, stroll
along Nakamise shopping street to
browse a variety of traditional, local
snacks and souvenirs

【Tokyo Sky Tree(Farseek)】 You may even catch a glimpse of Sky Tree from the Asakusa area!

【Kabukicho Shinjuku】 A major commercial and administrative center, housing the busiest train station in the world

【 Tokyo Metropolitan Government Observatory Deck 】 You will assend up to to observe view of Tokyo.

Day 4: Tokyo- Mt Fuji (B/L/D)

【 Ameyoko Shopping Street 】 One of the favorite pastimes of many a visitor to Japan is going on a souvenir shopping spree, hauling in as many amazing goods and deals as possible.

【Gotemba Factory Outlet】 The stores found at the Premium Outlets are the outlets of internationally known brands of fashion, sports, food, household goods and electronics, and range from everyday items to luxury goods.

Coshino Hakkai The eight ponds of Oshino Hakkai are the beautiful byproduct of historic eruptions and intense volcanic activity. Several are fed by an underground reservoir and are renowned for their mineral-rich spring water.

Mt Fuji Ascend up to fifth-level (If weather's not permitting for an ascent, we will replace it with Mt.Fuji Musuem

Day5: Mt Fuji - Nagoya (B/L/D)

【Atsuta Jingu】 Atsuta Shrine stands in a pleasant, wooded park in southern Nagoya. During the Meiji Period, the shrine was remodeled after the Ise Shrines in the purely Japanese Shinmeizukuri architecture style.

【 Nagoya Castle 】 Nagoya Castle was completed in 1615 by the Shogun, Tokugawa leyasu. Topped with golden



shachihoko, votive tiger-fish roof devices, and boasting the largest floorspace of any tower keep, Nagoya Castle and its magnificent Hommaru Palace were operated as a military facility.

【 Sakae Shopping Street 】 With shopping, dining, bar-hopping and entertainment, Sakae is all about having fun.

Day 6: Nagoya- Kyoto-Osaka (B/L/D) Kiyomizu-dera It is one of the most celebrated temples of Japan. It was founded in 780 on the site of the Otowa Waterfall in the wooded hills east of Kyoto, and derives its name from the fall's pure waters.

【Fushimi Inari Taisha】 It is famous for its thousands of vermilion torii gates, which straddle a network of trails behind its main buildings.

【Arashiyama Bamboo Grove】 The

walking paths that cut through the bamboo groves make for a nice walk or bicycle ride. The groves are particularly attractive when there is a light wind and the tall bamboo stalks sway gently back and forth.

【 Togetsu-kyo Bridge 】 The bridge looks particularly attractive in combination

with the forested mountainside in the background.

Day 7: Osaka-Singapore (B)

【 Osaka Castle 】 (Not Including Osaka Castle Tower Admission.)

(Shinsaibashi) You will get a free and leisure timing to shop here and try Osaka local delights.

After you will take flight back to Singapore

第一天: 新加坡 **→** 名古屋 (机上用餐) 今天集合于樟宜机场, 搭乘航班前往日本 名古屋。

第二天:名古屋-高山-白川乡-长野 (午/晚餐)

【高山老街】这个老街保留了旧日本时 代的怀旧风情,老街上还有一排排保存良 好的老旧商店

【高山阵屋】高山阵屋原本是作为高山城主金森家的近郊宅邸之一而建造的,后

来从成为德川幕府直辖领地的 1692 年至 明治维新前的 176 年间,一直作为江户派 遣的代官或郡代执行飞騨国政务的政府机 构使用。

【白川乡合掌村】白川乡合掌村因为其 美丽的自然风光以及不可比拟的人文景观



被誉为日本历史风景。白川乡于 1976 年被选为重要的传统建筑保护区。1995 年,白川乡被列为联合国教科文组织世界遗产。

第三天: 长野-东京 (早/午/晚餐)

【雷门浅草寺】浅草寺是东京最古老的寺庙,这里供奉着观音菩萨的雕像,气氛庄严肃穆。巍峨的大门、五重佛塔、仲间世大道的各色小摊,都让浅草寺成为了日本旅游的打卡景点。

【天空之树 (远眺) 】运气好的话您可以在浅草寺观赏到这座东京新地标哦!

【新宿歌舞伎町】歌舞伎町代表日本乃 至整个亚洲最大的欢乐街歌舞伎町

【东京大都汇景色】您可以在这里俯瞰 东京迷人的景色

第四天: 东京-富士山 (早/午/晚餐) 【阿美横町】在这里几乎能以十分实惠 的价格买到任何物品。

【御殿场奥特莱斯】

【忍野八海】位于富士山下的小村落, 它的泉水的景色有如中国九寨沟的美称。 【富士山】在这里瞭望整个县区的风景 (如果天气不允许或封山, 行程将改去 富士资料馆)。

第五天: 富士山-名古屋 (早/午/晚)

【热田神宫】热田神宫是继伊势神宫之后的日本第二大受崇敬的神道神宫,其历史可追溯至 2000 多年前,热田神宫藏有草薙神剑,这把剑被比作亚瑟王的神剑,它是象征日本皇权的三大器物之一。【名古屋城】名古屋是日本最重要的城下町之一。名古屋城作为尾张德川宗族的定居点,是对抗劲敌大阪的第一道防线

【荣地下商业街】琳琅满目种类齐全的 商品让你轻松享受购物的乐趣, 过一把 购物瘾。

第六天:名古屋-京都-大阪(早/午/晚餐) 【清水寺】始建于大约 1200 年前的 778 年,自古以来就作为供奉观音菩萨的圣 灵之地,聚集了众多的参拜者。

【伏见稻荷大社】伏见稻荷大社是日本稻荷神社的总本社,供奉着保佑五谷丰登、生意兴隆的稻荷大神。通往稻荷山的朱红色鸟居色泽亮丽,看似无穷无尽,令人叹为观止,是日本最著名的景观之

【**岚山竹林**】岚山竹林小径位于京都以 西的嵯峨野村,小径不长,却足以让您 感受竹林之美。斑驳的光影落于林间地 面,仿佛有种不可思议的魔力。

【渡月桥】渡月桥一直是西部京都的岚山地区的地标,已有四百多年的历史了。 这座木桥横跨岚山山前的桂河。风景秀丽,春天的樱花和秋天的色彩吸引了大批人潮。

第七天:大阪-新加坡 (早餐)

【大阪城公园(不登天守阁)】历史悠久的大阪城,系丰臣秀吉于1586年所建,是由雄伟的石墙砌造而成,大阪城公园内城中央耸立着大阪城的主体建筑天守阁,巍峨宏伟,镶铜镀金,十分壮观。

【心斋桥自由购物】琳琅满目各式新潮的物品,之后前往道顿街品尝让日本人 难以忘怀的大阪风味美食。
