



## 7天5晚日本白川乡. 琵琶湖. 京都. 大阪

### 第一天：新加坡-名古屋 (MOB)

今晚您将前往新加坡樟宜国际机场搭乘您所选的国际航空飞往日本。



### 第二天：名古屋-白川乡-高山 (午/晚餐)

游览世界文化遗产—白川乡。白川乡至今仍保留着日本古代传统乡村建筑，村内散布着几十栋由茅草和木材搭建的房屋，屋顶如两手合掌时成60度的造型，因此得名合掌屋。合掌屋通常有四五层楼高，全部由人手搭建，不需一根钉。1995年，联合国教科文组织将白川乡列入世界文化遗产名录。高山，虽是个小城，但历史建筑和古街特别多，特殊的节庆活动也很著名。在这里您可以游览三町古街，这条古街依然能清晰地勾勒出城堡城市“高山”的影子。到此地一游，可亲眼观赏一下传统酒坊及门窗隔扇为格子造型的古老住宅。这一地区，已被日本政府指定为“重要传统建筑群保护区”。



### 第三天：高山-滋贺-长滨-琵琶湖 (早/午/晚餐)

黑壁广场建筑在明治时期作为银行而建。现用作玻璃馆，展示并销售玻璃制的饰品及音乐盒等。

彦根城是一所位于日本滋贺县彦根市金龟町的古城，也是日本国宝与国家古迹中仅存的四座木造城堡之一。该城完整地保留了江户时代以前的筑城方式。

玄宫园是位于彦根城东北部的大名庭园，园内模仿琵琶湖与学习中国潇湘八景而选出的近江八景进行造景。该日本代表性的大名庭园还入选为日本遗产。

琵琶湖是日本最大的淡水湖，被指定为国家公园。这里也有许多可以观赏樱花与红叶的景点，随着季节的变化都可观赏到不同的美景。近江八幡水乡游船，近江八幡的八幡堀水乡全长4750公尺，为一个樱花、流水、石道与典雅建筑相伴的赏樱谧境。入住温泉酒店



### 第四天：滋贺-京都-大阪 (早/午/晚餐)

京都锦市场。锦市场是一条很窄的购物街。这里有各式各样的新鲜及调理好的食物，还有许多京都特产，像是酱菜、日本甜点、干货、寿司，还有卖新鲜海产跟各式蔬菜。

岚山是京都西北的著名景区，平安时代是王朝贵族宅邸的聚集地。作为赏樱赏枫的圣地，岚山每到春秋两季吸引了大量游人，而风光秀美的嵯峨野竹林也流露着京都独特的韵味，横跨桂川的渡月桥是岚山的标志性景观，保留着木造结构的桥身与背后树木繁茂的群山构成一幅美不胜收的山水画卷，天龙寺以其精致的造景庭园而闻名，并被喻为“京都五大禅寺”之首。伏见稻荷大社，是深受京都人爱戴的神社之一，也是京都最古老的神社之一。

金阁寺正式名称其实是鹿苑寺，因为建筑物外面包有金箔，故又名金阁寺。

### Day 1: Singapore - Nagoya (MOB)

Tonight, assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to Japan for a pleasant & memorable journey.



### Day 2: Nagoya - Shirakawa - Takayama (L/D)

**Shirakawa-go**, declared a UNESCO world heritage site in 1995, they are famous for their traditional gassho-zukuri meaning "constructed like hands in prayer" farmhouses, some of which are more than 250 years old.

**Takayama**, although a small city, retains a traditional touch, especially in its beautifully preserved old town, **Sanmachi**, the old streets, the iconic district for sightseeing in Takayama. Many of the

district's restaurants and craft shops, along with sake breweries and old fashioned house cafes, use the original historic buildings.

### Day 3: Takayama - Shiga - Nagahama - Lake Biwa (Biwako) (B/L/D)

**Nagahama Black Wall (Kurokabe) Square** was built as a bank during the Meiji period. Now used as a glass gallery, display and sale of glass jewelry and music boxes.

**Hikone Castle** is a Japanese Edo-period castle in the city of Hikone, in Shiga Prefecture. It is considered the most significant historical building in Shiga. Hikone is one of only 12 Japanese castles with the original keep, and one of only five castles listed as a national treasure.

**Genkyuen Garden** is a Japanese landscape garden with a central pond and a circular walking trail.

**Lake Biwa**, the most biggest freshwater lake in Japan, **Omihachiman city - Suigo river boat ride** Enjoy the slowest vehicle in Japan, you can view the beautiful scenery that nature produces during each season from boat at Omihachiman's suigo.

### Day 4: Shiga - Kyoto - Osaka (B/L/D)


**Nishiki Market** is a narrow, five block long shopping street lined by more than one hundred shops and restaurants; and is a great place to find seasonal foods and Kyoto specialties, such as Japanese sweets, pickles, dried seafood and sushi.

**Arashiyama** is a pleasant, touristy district in the western outskirts of Kyoto. **Bamboo Groves** The walking paths that cut through the bamboo groves make for a nice walk. The groves are particularly attractive when there is a light wind and the tall bamboo stalks sway gently back and forth. **Togetsukyo Bridge**, The bridge looks particularly attractive in combination with the forested mountainside in the background. **Tenryuji Temple** is the largest and most impressive temple in Arashiyama. Founded in 1339 at the beginning of the Muromachi Period (1338-1573), the temple is one of Kyoto's

many UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

**Fushimi Inari Shrine**, is one of the most popular shrines in Japan. Known for its thousands of vermillion torii gates, which straddle a network of trails.

**Kinkakuji**, officially named Rukon-ji, is a Zen temple in northern Kyoto whose top two floors are completely covered in gold leaf.
