#### DAY 01 SINGAPORE - MILAN

Assemble at Singapore Changi International Airport for your flight to Milan – The Fashion City

#### DAY 02 MILAN

Welcome to Milan, Capital of Italy's finance and fashion industries. Upon arrival, we shall be transfer to the hotel for our well deserved rest.

#### DAY 03 MILAN - GENOA

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Start our day with a tour in Milan. Its origins are believed to be Celtic but it was conquered by Romans in 222BC and became a major trading and transport centre. We shall start our half day sightseeing in Milan which brings us to the Gothic Cathedral and the famous La Scala Opera House. Not to be missed is the Milan Duomo Square, which is the core of Milan. After lunch, you may want to shop at the famous 19<sup>th</sup> century Gallery Victor Emmanuel 2<sup>nd</sup>, a large glass-roofed building often called the living room of Milan, enhanced by the elegance of some of Milan's finest stores. Thereafter, transfer to Genoa for our overnight stay.

#### DAY 04 GENOA - CINQUE TERRE - PARMA

(Breakfast/ Dinner)

This morning, proceed on the highlight of our trip - Cinque Terre. Start the visit from Monterosso al Mare, the largest of the five villages and enjoy a gentle stroll along the fifth village of Cinque terre, Riomaggiore, a scenic coastal path to with romantic vistas over the Mediterranean Sea. Thereafter, transfer to Parma for our overnight rest.

#### DAY 05 PARMA - VERONA - VENICE

(Breakfast/Squid ink Spaghetti Dinner)

Make our way to Verona. Famous for being the setting of Shakespeare's "Romeo and Juliet." Visit and view the 14th-century residence with a tiny balcony overlooking a courtyard is said be "Juliet's House." The Verona Arena is a huge 1st-century Roman amphitheater, which currently hosts concerts and large-scale opera performances.

#### DAY 06 VENICE

(Breakfast)

After breakfast, we introduces you to 'hidden Venice' - the back lanes and 'campi', small squares, where tourists often tread. Upon emerging into **Piazza San Marco**, admire **St. Mark's Basilica** and see the lavish pink marbled **Doge's Palace**, with its **Bridge of Sighs**. Next, we make our way to the Noventa Factory outlet in Venice for our shopping. Enjoy discounts up to 70% with brands like Prada, Gucci, Ferragamo, Marc Jacobs, Bottega Veneta and many many more.

#### DAY 07 VENICE - SAN MARINO

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Discover the ancient charm of San Marino, the world's oldest republic, on this private walking tour. Start at the historic Gate of Saint Francis before walking through the bustling square of La Saponeria Del Titano. Visit Palazzo Pubblico, the government building displaying impressive architecture and see Cava dei Balestrieri, a site steeped in history.

#### DAY 08 SAN MARINO - PISA - FLORENCE - TUSCANY REGION

(Breakfast/Florentine steak w wine Dinner)

After breakfast, we shall depart San Marino as we drive towards Florence via Pisa. Upon arrival, we shall start our orientation tour in Pisa with a visit to the incredible Piazza del Duomo – a must for every tourist. Enjoy the spectacular view of the Pisa Cathedral, Pisa baptistery and the world famous Leaning of Pisa. Thereafter, continue to Florence. Arrive in Florence – a great city where Renaissance Art and Culture flourished for centuries. Enjoy a Florence walking tour with a stop at the lofty Santa Maria Cathedral, then continue on to see the Doors of Paradise at the Baptistry of Giovanni, a matchless work of bronze which took 27 years to complete!

#### DAY 09 TUSCANY REGION - SAN GIMIGNANO SIENA

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Traveling to San Gimignano is a wonderful journey through Tuscany's picturesque countryside. Start the visit at the main square, Piazza del Duomo, where you'll be surrounded by stunning medieval buildings. Admire the Collegiate Church of Santa Maria Assunta, with its impressive frescoes. Thereafter, continue to Siena. Upon arrival, Start at Piazza del Campo, Siena's famous shell-shaped square. It's the heart of the city and one of Italy's most beautiful squares. Take in the sights of the Palazzo Pubblico (Town Hall) with its stunning facade, and the Fonte Gaia, a beautiful fountain.

#### DAY 10 SIENA - ROME

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Welcome to Rome, the Eternal City. This capital city stands on the Tiber River and enjoys a long and celebrated history. Your included sightseeing tour with a Local Specialist begins at the World's largest cathedral, **St. Peter's Basilica** (Outside view). Next, continue to visit **Palazzo Massimo alle Terme (National Roman Museum)**. The palace is the main seat of the museum as well as the headquarters of the Agency of the Ministry of Cultural Heritage and Activities of Italy, in charge for the archaeological heritage of Rome. Thereafter, your tour continues with views of ancient Roman ruins including the **enormous Colosseum**. Lastly, we make a stop at the **Fountain of Trevi** where you may want to throw a coin into the fountain and make a wish! **(Due to the Jubilee year celebration, disruption in Itineraries are expected. No prior notice will be given if there are any changes/no go. No replacement will be make on the above mentioned.)**

#### DAY 11 ROME - POMPEII\* - SORRENTO

(Breakfast/Seafood Dinner)

This morning, we depart Rome as we continue on our journey to Naples via Pompeii. The city of Pompeii was an ancient Roman town-city near modern Naples in the Italian region of Campania, in the territory of the comune of Pompei. Pompeii, along with Herculaneum and many villas in the surrounding area, was mostly destroyed and buried under 4 to 6 m (13 to 20 ft) of ash and pumice in the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD. You might consider joining an Optional guided tour of the Pompeii Archaeological site at your own expenses. Thereafter, we shall continue to Sorrento for for our overnight stay.

#### DAY 12 SORRENTO - ISLES OF CAPRI - SORRENTO

(Breakfast/Dinner)

This morning, we depart Sorrento as we continue on our journey to Capri to embark on an excursion by ferry to the Isle of Capri where we will enjoy a walking tour of Capri Town and Gardens, leaving us some time on our own to explore this lovely island. Thereafter, we transfer back to Rome for our overnight stay.
